## **John Denver Tribute Concert Set for Sept. 4**

Rocky Mountain High comes alive when singer songwriter Brad Fitch takes the stage for the John Denver Tribute Concert on Saturday, Sept. 4 at the Fairgrounds at Stanley Park in Estes Park.

Wearing his signature round wire rims and cowboy hat, Fitch revives the John Denver legacy by performing his most beloved songs, including *Back Home Again, Sweet Surrender, Thank God I'm a Country Boy, I'm Sorry, Calypso, Fly Away, Take Me Home, Country Roads, Rocky Mountain High, Sunshine on My Shoulders and Annie's Song*.

The Dennis-Tobias Band opens the show at 5 p.m. A local Estes Park favorite, this band performs a mix of classic rock, Motown, blues, swing and soul with a kick of country from the 60s, 70s and 80s. Brad Fitch and the TropiCowboy Band begin performing at 6:30 p.m.
